

Golf Rules

Singles

- Bring some form of Law enforcement or Fire department identification active or retired.
- Wear golf attire with a collared polo style shirt, no cut off shorts and no blue jeans.
- Lift clean and replace only on fairways or greens. A one shot penalty will be assessed if done in rough or hazard areas.
- Players will sign score cards and have another player witness the card who is not from your department.
- Single digit handicaps will play from the back tees
- Age 65 and older may play from the forward tees
- Women may play from the women's tees or any tee box behind the women's tee.

Two Person

- Bring some form of Law enforcement or Fire department identification active or retired
- Wear golf attire with a collared polo style shirt, no cut off shorts and no blue jeans.
- Lift clean and replace only on fairways or greens. A one shot penalty will be assessed if done in rough or hazard areas.
- Players will sign score cards and have another player witness the card who is not from your department.
- Single digit handicaps will play from the back tees
- Age 65 and older may play from the forward tees
- Women may play from the women's tees or any tee box behind the women's tee.

Par 3 tournament

- Bring some form of Law enforcement or Fire department identification active or retired
- Wear golf attire with a collared polo style shirt, no cut off shorts and no blue jeans.
- Lift clean and replace only on the green. A one shot penalty will be assessed if done anywhere but on the green.
- There will be only one tee box for all competitors.

Four person scramble (select shot)

- Bring some form of Law enforcement or Fire department identification active or retired
- Wear golf attire with a collared polo style shirt, no cut off shorts and no blue jeans.
- Teams will play from the red tees

- Age 65 and older may play from the forward tees
- Women may play from the blue tees or the red tees
- Lift clean and replace only on fairways or greens. A one shot penalty will be assessed if done in rough or hazard areas.
- Each team must use 4 tee shots from each player and those shots will be marked on the scorecard.
- Each team member will hit a shot and then the team chooses the shot they wish to use and each player will hit their next shot from that site.
