Tactical Drone Operations

- Competition Categories:
1. Drone Agility Course (40 pts. Max: 1st-40 pts., 2nd-25 pts., 3rd-10 pts.)
 2. Tactical Drone Operation (60 pts. Max: 1st-60 pts., 2nd-40 pts., 3rd- 20 pts.)

Category Description:

1. Drone Agility Course- Drone operator/competitor will be given an obstacle course with a designated route to perform. The course will be scored based on time. Time penalties will be added for specified "fouls". Example of a foul: hitting a cone/obstacle. Fouls will be outlined for the drone operator prior to the start of the obstacle course. There will also be a time cap for this course.
2. Tactical Drone Operation- Drone operator/competitor will be given a mission-based scenario that would apply to public safety drone operations. The drone operator/competitor will have to locate a set number of clues (based on the scenario) and provide the documentation (photos/video) of the clues to the judges. Score will be based on time, ability to locate clues pertaining to scenario, and quality of the documentation.

General Guidelines:

1. Bring your own drones.
2. Bring proof of drone pilot authorization or your department's authorization.
3. Drone operators/competitors must follow all FAA regulations for drone operations.
4. Drone operators/competitors can compete in either or both categories. Overall ranking will be based on a 100 point scale.
Example: Competitor gets 2nd place in Drone Agility and 1st place in Tactical Drone Operation, they will have overall 85 points.
